He previously served as Assistant Professor at the University of the Philippines Open University, where he also chaired the MPM program, and now continues to teach in its Public Management and ASEAN Studies programs as a Senior Lecturer.'

He holds an MA in Asia-Pacific Studies (with a cognate in Political Economy) from National Chengchi University in Taiwan (National University of Governance), where he was a Taiwan Scholar, and a Bachelor of Public Administration from the University of the Philippines National College of Public Administration and Governance, ), where he also lectured as an affiliate faculty.
